Fund Description

The Global Bond Fund is a diverse, actively managed portfolio of global fixed-income securities. The average duration of the fund will normally vary within +/-3 years of the benchmark. The fund invests primarily in a diversified portfolio of investment grade bonds denominated in major world currencies.

Potential Investor Benefits

The fund offers the potential for more efficient returns through a diversified regional and sector exposure.

Potential Fund Advantage The fund's extensive global opportunity set can offer diversified sources of returns, benefiting from the manager's views on interest rates, currencies, credit and country trends.

Risk and Reward profile

Counterparty Risk: Other financial institutions provide services such as safekeeping of assets or as a counterparty to financial contracts such as derivatives. The fund is exposed to the risk of bankruptcy, or other type of default of transaction counterparties. Credit and Default Risk: A decline in the financial health of an obligation. 


Chart shows performance from the first month-end, rebased to 100, for the oldest share class.











Sector Allocation (%DWE)
